Thanks to good experiences in running directed fishing of cyprinid fish in the Archipelago Sea, John Nurminen Foundation will repeat the concept in the coastal waters of the Bothnian Sea. With the help of local fishermen, the project will remove 50 tons of fish, corresponding to 0,4 t of phosphorus from the Bothnian Sea.
